Most Britons think MPs make decisions based on their own interests

25 November 2021, London – Our research into British public opinion and voting intentions finds that a large proportion of people in Britain think MPs make decisions based on their own interests, and a majority believe MPs should not be allowed to have second jobs. Britons are concerned about further waves of COVID-19 infections during the winter, and half of Britons think COVID-19 vaccines should be mandatory for all adults.

Key findings from Kantar Public's research, which took place between 18 and 22 November, include:

- Seven in ten Britons (72%) think MPs make decisions to a large extent/to some extent based on what will further their career. In addition, 71% say they make decisions to a large extent/to some extent benefit their own financial interests.
- Over half (55%) of people think MPs should not be allowed to have second jobs. One in four (25%) think they should be allowed; 20% don't know.
- 74% (+4 vs October 2021) are very/fairly concerned that there will be further waves of COVID-19 infections during the winter. 20% (-4) are not very/not at all concerned.
- Half of Britons (50%) (+5) think that COVID-19 vaccines should be compulsory for all adults, 37% (-8) think that adults should be allowed to choose.
- 47% of Britons report that the COP26 summit was not very/not at all successful in reaching
 a deal that would effectively tackle climate change. One third (31%) thought the summit was
 very/somewhat successful and 22% do not know.
- 46% of people think that the measures agreed at the COP26 summit do not go far enough to tackle climate change, while only 10% think they do go far enough, and 6% think that they go too far. 37% say they do not know enough about the measures agreed to provide a view.

MPs decision making and second jobs

This month's research reveals that a large proportion of people think that MPs decision making is largely driven by their own vested interests:

- Seven in ten Britons (72%) think MPs make decisions to a large extent/to some extent based on what will further their political career.
- 71% think they make decisions to a large extent / to some extent to benefit their own financial interests.
- Just under half of people (47%) think MPs make decisions to a large extent/to some extent based on what they think is right.
- Only a third of the public (33%) think they make decisions to a large extent/to some extent based on what is beneficial for the public.

Over half (55%) of people think MPs should not be allowed to have second jobs. Only 25% think they should be allowed; 20% don't know.

Article 16 of the Northern Ireland protocol

People in Britain are divided over what the government should do about the rules governing trade between Northern Ireland and the rest of the UK:

- 31% think the government should change the current arrangement to make the rules the same for Northern Ireland and the rest of the UK, even if this means the EU may respond with counter measures.
- 28% think the government should stick with the current arrangement and keep in place the trade agreement already negotiated with the EU.
- 41% do not know what the government should do.

Food, petrol, and medicine shortages

Britons remain concerned about potential shortages, 63% are very/fairly concerned about shortages of fresh food in the coming months (+3). 33% are not very/not at all concerned (-3).

- More than half (53%) of Britons are very/fairly concerned about shortages of petrol or diesel over the next few months (-1). 41% are not very/not at all concerned (+1).
- Over half (56%,+4) are very/fairly concerned about there being shortages of medicine over the next few months. 39% are not very/not at all concerned (-2).

Attitudes towards COVID-19 and actions to tackle the pandemic

When asked the government's management of the pandemic and balance of public health and economy, we found that there is mounting concern around rising COVID-19 cases this winter, and dissatisfaction with the government's handling of the pandemic, is increasing:

- 74% (+4) are very/fairly concerned that there will be further waves of COVID-19 infections through the winter.
- 50% (+5) think that vaccines should be compulsory for all adults. 37% (-8) think that adults should be allowed to choose.
- Seven in ten people (70%, -6) say they are very/somewhat satisfied with the vaccine rollout organised by the government and health authorities. 21% are not very/not at all satisfied with the vaccine rollout (+4).
- 42% of people think that the government is placing too much emphasis on protecting the country's economy, and not enough on protecting people's health (+5). This is the highest figure since September 2020. 23% think it has got the balance about right (-1).
- 40% think the government has handled the pandemic very/fairly well (-2) and 51% think very/fairly poorly (no change).

Views around climate change

The public are critical of action taken at the COP26 summit and of global co-operation:

- 47% of Britons think that the COP26 summit was not very/not at all successful at agreeing a
 deal that would successfully tackle climate change. One third (31%) thought the summit was
 very/somewhat successful and 22% do not know whether the summit was successful or not.
- 46% of people think that the measures agreed at the COP26 summit do not go far enough to tackle climate change, while only 10% think they do go far enough, and 6% think they go too far. 37% do not know enough about the agreed measures to provide a view.
- 56% (+2) of Britons rate global cooperation between countries to tackle climate change as very poor/poor, while only 27% (-2) would rate it as very good/good.
- 63% (+5 vs September 2021) of people say that they would be willing to make a lot of changes/some changes to how they live and work to help reduce the effects of climate change. One fifth (20%, +1) would be willing to make only a few changes, and 7% (-5) would not be willing to make any changes.

A total of 1,119 interviews were conducted online among adults living in Great Britain between the 18 and 22 November 2021. All interviews were conducted online using the Kantar Research Express. The Kantar online access panel was the main sample source.

Polling Methodological Note - November 2021

A representative sample of 1,119 adults in Great Britain were interviewed between the 18^h and 22nd November 2021. All interviews were conducted online using the Kantar Research Express. The Kantar online access panel was the main sample source.

The data was weighted to match population totals for age, gender, 2019 General Election voting patterns, 2016 EU referendum voting patterns, education, region, and likelihood to vote in the next General Election. Further details on the weighting are given on page two.

We have updated our weighting scheme, compared with last month we made the following changes:

- Where possible targets have been updated to use more up to date statistics. The sources for the population totals are provided above each table.
- The EU referendum weighting targets have been adjusted to account for population changes since 2016 (deaths and emigration)
- The 2019 general election weighting targets are now at the GB-level rather than nested within nation. Sensitivity analysis which we conducted indicated this change would not have a substantial effect on point estimates, but would improve precision

Using exactly the same weighting approach as last month, the headline voting intention figures are: Conservative (39%), Labour (36%) and Lib Dems (9%).

Voting intentions

The voting intention figures provided aim to show the current political opinion of the nation rather than to accurately predict the outcome of the next General Election.

As well as weighting the data, a Likelihood to Vote (LTV) Model has been used to estimate the voting probability of each respondent. These probabilities vary by stated likelihood of voting and whether reported voting in the 2019 general election. The probabilities themselves are based on those of respondents that participated in our polls immediately before and after the 2019 General Election.

Uncertainty

All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that it lies within 2 points.

Sampling variance

We have estimated the sampling variation in our voting intention estimates using the methodology proposed by Kuha and Sturgis (2017¹). Bootstrap resampling was used to draw fifty sets of respondents from the achieved sample (in a way which matched the quota sampling design), each of these new samples was weighted and we have then used the distribution of estimates (from the resamples) to calculate margins of error (the range containing all but the two most extreme resample results).

- Conservative Party = 35.4% to 41.3%
- Labour Party = 32.1% to 39.7%
- Conservative lead over Labour = -2.9%pts to 8.8%pts

Weighting

Weights have been applied to the sample to ensure that it is representative of the general public in Great Britain aged 18+. The sources for the population totals are provided in each table.

^{**}The weighting targets have been revised to account for deaths and emigration since the 2016 referendum. The face-to-face 2017 British Election Survey was used to obtain estimated voting distributions for different age bands. ONS data was then used to estimate the number of deaths and the number of UK citizens to have emigrated since 2016 in each of these age bands. The size of each the Leave and Remain votes were then adjusted to reflect these population changes.

Likelihood to Vote in General Election

We have estimated the likelihood that each respondent will vote in the next General Election. This value is based on respondents' stated intention to vote and whether they voted in the last general election. The expected population turnout has been included as a population total in the weighting matrix. This turnout has been estimated based on the relationship between sample and population turnout rates in the 2017 general election.
